3. The contract appointments are temporary in nature, non-transferable, job/post specific, non-pensionable & conferring no right for regularization. The contract appointment will be upto 30.06.2023 which can be extended/reduced upto project period with the approval of competent authority.
4. Retired persons are not eligible.
5. The recruitments will be made strictly on merit on all Punjab basis in accordance with the rules, selection criteria and other provisions of Recruitment Policy, 2022 and Contract Appointment Policy, 2004.

Late and incomplete applications will not be considered and only eligible candidates will be called for test/interview. No TA/DA shall be paid.
